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Annual Summary


During 2014, the Clackamas County Sheriff's Office provided law enforcement service to the City of Wilsonville on a 24 hour a day basis. During this time period, the Sheriff's Office answered 6,558 calls for service, which was an average of 546.5 calls per month and 18.0 calls per day.

The yearly average during the previous three years was 5,826.0 and 485.5 per month. The 6,558 calls handled during 2014 reflect a 12.6% increase in 2014 over the three year average.

Below is a chart showing the number of calls for service in the City during the past five years.

Yearly Calls for Service





2014 Calls for Service by Shift




2014 Calls for Service by Month











Wilsonville Reported Burglaries 2014





Wilsonville Reported Stolen Vehicles 2014





2014 Traffic Stops and Citations by Month






