

ORDINANCE NO. 277

AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 11.040 OF THE WILSONVILLE CODE REGARDING WAIVER, REIMBURSEMENT, OR PAY BACK OF FEES.


THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 11.040 is hereby added to Chapter 11 of the Wilsonville Code as follows:


"11.040 Fees - Waiver. The City Council shall have the authority to waive, reimburse, or pay back in part or in whole, any fees provided for by this Code, when good cause therefor is shown."

Section 2. It being determined by the Wilsonville City Council an emergency exists, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final reading and passage by the Wilsonville City Council.


