RESOLUTION NO. 1520

A RESOLUTION DECLARING MATERIAL AND EQUIPMENT AS SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THEIR RELEASE TO THE SOUTHWEST SUBURBAN SEWER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has prepared a list of material and equipment, attached hereto as Exhibit A, owned by the City of Wilsonville which has been declared to be surplus to the City's needs; and

WHEREAS, Wilsonville City code, Section 2.310, authorizes any purchase, lease or sale by the City Council of personal property, public improvements, or services other than agreements which are exclusively for personal service; and

WHEREAS, the Southwest Suburban Sewer District, Seattle, Washington, has interest in adding seven used Rotating Biological Contractor (RBC) shafts (and related appertances) to their existing RBC wastewater treatment process.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The materials and equipment listed on the attached Exhibit A, are no longer needed by the City of Wilsonville and are declared surplus property.
- 2. The Southwest Suburban Sewer District, Seattle, Washington, is authorized to accept the surplus materials and equipment, at no cost to the City of Wilsonville.
- 3. Southwest Suburban will pay all costs of removal and shipping of the RBC units to their Miller Creek facility.
