

RESOLUTION NO. 1621

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE SUPPORTING AND ENDORSING THE CLACKAMAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOND MEASURE TO BE PRESENTED TO THE VOTERS OF CLACKAMAS COUNTY IN THE MAY 2000 ELECTION.

WHEREAS, over 760 residents of Wilsonville attended Clackamas Community College last year; and

WHEREAS, in the last three years, 32 Wilsonville High School graduates went directly to Clackamas Community College; and

WHEREAS, 75 students from Wilsonville High School took Advanced College Credit classes while still in high school last year and received 232 college credits at a tuition value of \$9,280 to help defray high college costs; and

WHEREAS, nearly 2000 people enrolled in the CCC Community Education classes held in West Linn and Wilsonville to extend the opportunities for lifelong learning for residents; and

WHEREAS, nearly 170 employees of seven companies in Wilsonville received 211 hours of training through Customized Training; and


WHEREAS, last year 10 Wilsonville small business owners received start-up and management assistance from the Clackamas Community College Small Business Development Center; and

WHEREAS, Clackamas Community College contributes both directly and indirectly to the residents of Wilsonville.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WILSONVILLE CITY COUNCIL.


1. The City Council supports and endorses the bond measure for Clackamas Community College to be presented to the voters in May 2000.
