

**RESOLUTION NO. 1647**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE REVISING ARTICLE 4, SECTION 6 OF RESOLUTION NO. 1129 AND INCREASING THE SURCHARGE FEE FOR STORM DRAINAGE SERVICES FROM \$1.40 PER EQUIVALENT DWELLING UNIT TO \$2.06 PER EQUIVALENT DWELLING UNIT PER MONTH EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2000**

WHEREAS, the surcharge fee for storm drainage services was approved by Council adoption of Resolution No. 1129 on August 15, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the rate of \$1.40 per equivalent dwelling per unit per month has not been changed since 1994; and

WHEREAS, a draft Storm Water Master Plan is under review by the Planning Commission and is projected to be submitted to the City Council for approval this summer; and

WHEREAS, the Storm Water Master Plan includes capital improvements projects with a current construction cost of \$8,318,000; and

WHEREAS, changes in storm water quality requirements require significant expenditures that benefit existing property owners; and

WHEREAS, the financing chapter of the Storm Water Master Plan includes several alternatives for financing of the construction of storm water master plan facilities; and


WHEREAS, all alternatives will require an increase in the storm water fee to at least \$2.06 per equivalent dwelling unit; and

WHEREAS, a recommendation to increase the storm water systems development charges will be forwarded to Council as soon as the Storm Water Master Plan is adopted.

**NOW, THEREFORE THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Article 4, Section 6 of Resolution No. 1129 is hereby modified to increase the storm water fee to \$2.06 per equivalent dwelling unit per month effective July 1, 2000.

ADOPTED by the Wilsonville City Council at a regular Council meeting thereof this 5<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2000, and filed with the Wilsonville City Recorder this same date.
