

RESOLUTION NO. 1711

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY STAFF TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR A TRANSPORTATION AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT PROGRAM GRANT FOR AMENDING THE EXISTING COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, DEVELOPMENT CODE AND PUBLIC WORKS STANDARDS TO REFLECT THE REVISED REQUIREMENTS OF THE UPDATED TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Departments of Transportation, and Land Conservation and Development, have developed Transportation and Growth Management Program grants for planning projects that lead to more livable, transportation-efficient, compact, pedestrian-friendly communities; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City of Wilsonville to amend its Comprehensive Plan, Development Code, and Public Works Standards to meet the requirements of the updated Transportation Systems Plan to comply with State Transportation Planning Rule (Goal 12 Administrative Rule, OAR 660-12); and


WHEREAS, development and adoption of ordinances to implement the updated Transportation Systems Plan is an eligible activity for application under this grant program; and

WHEREAS, the grant application must include evidence of support for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council authorizes and directs staff to prepare and make application for a transportation and growth management program grant for development of ordinances to amend the existing Comprehensive Plan, Development Code and Public Works Standards to reflect the revised requirements of the updated Transportation System Plan.
