A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE CONDEMNING THE DISSEMINATION OF RACIST LITERATURE IN THE COMMUNITY

WHEREAS, racist flyers denigrating Hispanics were recently distributed to a number of households in the City and posted at the Wilsonville Library; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that all citizens regardless of race, creed or background have the fundamental right to feel safe and secure in their home and community; and,

WHEREAS, Wilsonville is a community that respects, values and celebrates cultural diversity; and,

WHEREAS, acts of hate and intimidation based upon race or cultural background is antiethical to the values of a community founded upon inclusivity and diversity.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Wilsonville City Council condemns any act of hatred, racism or prejudice in any form; and declares that acts of this nature cannot and will not be tolerated in this community.
 - 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
