## **RESOLUTION NO. 2137**

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING BALLOT MEASURE 3-308, A \$98 MILLION BOND MEASURE FOR SCHOOL FACILITY ADDITIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS IN THE WEST LINN/WILSONVILLE SCHOOL DISTRICT, AND URGING A "YES" VOTE IN THE NOVEMBER 4, 2008, MAIL-IN ELECTION.

WHEREAS, enrollment in the West Linn/Wilsonville School District has nearly doubled in size to 8,300 students over the past 20 years; and

WHEREAS, the projected annual increase of 1.5% will grow the enrollment to approximately 9,200 students in 2015; and

WHEREAS, the District enrollment currently exceeds facility capacity necessitating the use of 14 portable classrooms housing 400 students across the District; and

WHEREAS, many of the school buildings in the District are in need of repair, renovation and improvement; and

WHEREAS, suitable land for new and needed school buildings is becoming increasingly scarce in the District and must therefore be acquired today in order to ensure its availability in the future; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wilsonville and the West Linn/Wilsonville School District have, by inter-governmental agreement, been conducting ongoing long-range planning for new school facilities which include a new 500 student primary school in Wilsonville, site planning for a future middle school in Wilsonville, and athletic field improvements at the Wilsonville High School; and

WHEREAS, the West Linn/Wilsonville School Board has referred to the voters of the District a bond measure in the amount of \$98 million, which will appear on the November 4, 2008, mail-in ballot as measure 3-308.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Wilsonville City Council endorses ballot measure 3-308 and urges a "yes" vote in the November 4, 2008, mail-in election.
- 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
