#### RESOLUTION NO. 2245

#### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER OF BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN CERTAIN FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009-10.

WHEREAS, the City adopted a budget and appropriated funds for fiscal year 2009-10 by Resolutions 2181 and 2182; and,

WHEREAS, certain expenditures are expected to exceed the original adopted budget in some of the City's funds and budgetary transfers are necessary within these funds to provide adequate appropriation levels to expend the unforeseen costs; and,

WHEREAS, ORS 294.450 provides that a city may transfer appropriations within appropriation categories provided the enabling resolution states the need for the transfer, purpose of the expenditure and corresponding amount of appropriation; and,

WHEREAS, all transfers from contingencies within the fiscal year to date aggregate to not more than ten percent (10%) of the fund's total appropriations, with transfers exceeding this limit being referred via a separate supplemental budget request; and,

WHEREAS, to facilitate clarification of the adjustments in this resolution, Attachment A to this resolution provides a summary by fund of the appropriation categories affected by the proposed transfer of budget appropriation and the purpose of the expenditure.

### NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City amends the estimated appropriations within the funds and categories delineated and explained in Attachment A.
  - 2. This resolution becomes effective upon adoption.
