

RESOLUTION NO. LVII

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF TENNIS COURTS AT WILSONVILLE MEMORIAL PARK AS A MEMORIAL TO MARGUERITE THOMASON AND FOR THE USE AND BENEFIT OF THE CITIZENS OF WILSONVILLE.

WHEREAS, Marguerite Thomason (now deceased) was until the time of her death a member of the Wilsonville City Council and served with enthusiasm, honor and distinction in that capacity, and is now mourned by her many friends and fellow citizens; and

WHEREAS, to insure a lasting memorial to a long-time friend, supporter and community action advocate, funds have been donated to the City of Wilsonville for the "Marguerite Thomason Memorial Tennis Court Fund," and the purpose for the use of such fund was determined by Miss Thomason's interest in youth and youth activities as well as the fact that she was an avid tennis player during her younger years, and the Wilsonville City Council has determined that the construction of tennis courts for the aforesaid purposes is a community project which appears to be approved and supported by many citizens and is in the best interests of all of the citizens of the City of Wilsonville; and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications for the tennis court project have been prepared by the firm of Balsiger, Peterson, Shewdrige & Associates, Architects of Wilsonville, Oregon, which have been approved by the Wilsonville City Council, and the call for bids for the construction of such project was duly advertised and bids were opened and considered on July 30, 1974, and the lowest and best bid, which was also an acceptable bid, was that of James C. Turin of Wemme, Oregon, whose bid as accepted was for a total construction cost of \$19,170.00; and

WHEREAS, the successful bidder is ready, willing and able to proceed with the construction contract in accordance with the plans, specifications and proposal for the said project, and it is necessary that a formal contract be approved and executed by said

contractor and the City of Wilsonville; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council for the City of Wilsonville, Clackamas and Washington Counties, Oregon, that the bid proposal of James C. Turin, aka Turin & Sons Paving Contractors, for the construction of two tennis courts with related fencing at the Wilsonville Memorial Park in and for the City of Wilsonville according to the plans and specifications for said project and for the total bid price of \$19,170.00 is hereby approved and accepted; and the Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver in the name of and on behalf of the City of Wilsonville an appropriate construction contract, and that the bid price be paid upon receipt of billings and approval by the City's Engineers and the City Council with the funds donated or otherwise contributed to the City for that purpose and now on hand in the "Marguerite Thomason Memorial Tennis Court Fund;" and that the project when completed be dedicated as a lasting memorial to former Councilwoman, friend of all who knew her, and dedicated Wilsonville community supporter, Marguerite Thomason.

Adopted by the Wilsonville City Council at a regular meeting thereof this 26th day of August, 1974.
