A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REFUND OF SEWER AND WATER FEES TO CHARBONNEAU.

WHEREAS, a review of the records indicate that permits for Lots L-05, L-08, L-23 and L-28 shown above, and in addition for Permit #78240 for Lot L-19 were allowed as a credit and Permits #97111 and #79112 for two restrooms were issued on September 5, 1979 thus cancelling the requested refunds on the Neighborhood "L" lots, and

WHEREAS, no credit has been allowed, nor refund made on the "G" lots listed above, and

WHEREAS, the credit due on the "G" lots is \$1,050 paid as Water Fees and \$2,830 as Sewer Fees for a total of \$3,880 total refund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE, that the developers of Charbonneau Village at Wilsonville be refunded \$3,880 for the building permit fees heretofore paid with such change to be charged \$1,050 to Water and \$2,830 to Sewer Funds.
