

RESOLUTION NO. 220

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 204, ARTICLE III SECTION 5 AND ARTICLE IV SECTION 3.

WHEREAS, due to a transcribing error the deletion of fees and terminology provided in the original draft of Resolution 204 was inadvertently omitted and it is necessary to amend Resolution 204;

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City of Wilsonville that: Resolution 204 shall be amended as follows:

Article III Section 5 pg. 5 and 6 shall read:


	<u>Minimum Monthly Charge</u>	<u>User Fee</u>	<u>Surcharge</u>
Commercial and Industrial	\$13.75/mo./unit if less than 2000ft <sup>3</sup> /mo. of water consumed	*\$.007/cu.ft./mo.	*\$.005/cu.ft./month under the following conditions: 1. Water Consumption greater than 220,000 cu.ft./month per structure or building connected to public sewer 2. B.O.D. loading of more than 750 pounds/month 3. S.S. of more than 750 pounds/month

And Article IV Section 3 pg. 7 shall read:


Section 3. The sewer connection fee is based upon existing or intended use of the property at the time of application for connection. If the property is improved, expanded, subdivided or otherwise modified so as to increase the sewer connection fee due for that property or structure, a sewer connection fee shall be charged for the modified portion of the property or structure based on the sewer connection fee in effect at the time of the modifications. The sewer

connection fee paid for a specific sewer service for a residential, commercial or industrial unit shall be valid for a 1 year period from date of issuance of the sewer connection permit. After the 1 year period the sewer connection will have expired. The Building Official will then in writing notify the permittee that the permit has expired. The written notification of sewer connection permit expiration shall state the permittee has (10) ten days from the receipt of the expiration notice to request an extension time of the sewer connection permit. If there has been no response within 10 days the connection fee shall be considered forfeited. The permittee shall then be required to reapply for a sewer connection permit and pay the sewer connection fee in effect at the time of reapplication.
