

RESOLUTION NO. 226

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING STATE WIDE BALLOT MEASURE NO. 1, USE OF STATE BOND PROCEEDS TO FINANCE MUNICIPAL WATER PROJECTS.


WHEREAS, this measure is the financial assistance component of the Governor's package on drinking water, and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Legislature passed companion legislation in 1981 defining eligible projects which include dams, storage reservoirs, wells or well systems, pumping plants, pipelines, canals, ditches and all other structures and facilities necessary or convenient for supplying water, and

WHEREAS, this measure could assist in obtaining additional drinking water, therefore, by meeting the City's obligation in serving the citizens of Wilsonville.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Wilsonville City Council supports this Constitutional Amendment Ballot Measure No. 1, supporting State bond proceeds for municipal water projects.

ADOPTED by the Wilsonville City Council at a regular meeting thereof this 3rd day of May, 1982 and filed with the Wilsonville City Recorder this same day.
