RESOLUTION NO. 227

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING STATE WIDE BALLOT MEASURE NO. 3, USE OF STATE BOND PROCEEDS TO FINANCE CORRECTION FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon has experienced a need for additional correctional facilities due particularly to the rapid population growth, and

WHEREAS, the State has attempted to reduce the need for construction of additional prison facilities through passage of the Community Corrections Act placing emphasis on probation staff, and

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure No. 3 will amend the State Constitution authorizing the State to sell up to sixty million dollars (\$60,000,000.00) in general obligation bonds for a period of no more than ten (10) years for construction of local and state correctional facilities, and

WHEREAS, the Constitutional Amendment will not place an additional burden on property taxpayers, but will be a cost of three dollars (\$3.00) per person annually.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Wilsonville City Council supports Ballot Measure No. 3 amending the State's Constitution to finance Correctional Facilities.
