RESOLUTION NO. 232

A RESOLUTION FOR THE APPROVAL TO PURCHASE A BALANCE SCALE FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT TO REPLACE THE BALANCE SCALE STOLEN THE NIGHT OF MARCH 26, 1982.

WHEREAS, the City of Wilsonville Wastewater Treatment Plant is required by the Department of Environmental Quality of the State of Oregon to continually monitor the wastewater purification systems within the Treatment Plant and;

WHEREAS, the equipment utilized to meet those requirements established by the Department of Environmental Quality was stolen on the night of March 26, 1982 and;

WHEREAS, the City of Wilsonville is desirous to continuing to monitor and comply with those requirements established by the Department of Environmental Quality by replacing the equipment necessary to meet the requirements and;

WHEREAS, the City Council at their regularly held Council Meeting

April 19, 1982, at 7:30 pm in City Hall received a memo dated April 14,

1982, and entitled "REPLACEMENT PURCHASE - BALANCE SCALE" from Larry

Blanchard - Public Works Director with a subsequent memo from Jerry LaPierre

Wastewater Treatment Superintendent, the memo was written to Council for

the purpose of making the following recommendations.

 Open bids were received from 3 firms which distribute and sell Electronic balance scale with locking device - V.W.R.
 Scientific, American Scientific and Q.C. Services.

- Approve the purchase from V.W.R. Scientific Inc. of a Mettler AC100 Balance Scale with locking device for \$1,767.00.
- Money reimbursed from the insurance company would go back to the sewer fund.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, the Wilsonville City Council approved the purchase of a Mettler AC 100 Balance scale with locking device from V.W.R. Scientific Inc. for a total purchase price of \$1,767 including the recommendations from April 19, 1982, memo from the Public Works Director as designated herein.
