

RESOLUTION NO. 272

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A RATE FOR AGRICULTURAL WATER USE AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 203.

WHEREAS, the City staff has prepared a report on the need for an agricultural water use rate, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wilsonville reviewed the staff report at their meeting of August 16, 1982, and

WHEREAS, the City Council ordered that a Resolution be drafted and present at their next regular meeting to allow formal action to be taken.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Wilsonville does hereby amend Article IV of Resolution No. 203 by adding Section 2 to the Article as follows:


ARTICLE IV: BULK WATER RATE

Section 1. No change.

Section 2. Agricultural Use. Bulk water sales for agricultural purposes shall be at the rate of \$.00375 per cubic foot plus the total cost of employees salaries including fringe benefits related to the set-up, tear-down, turn-on or turn-off of water for such use. Agricultural purposes shall be limited to the growing of crops. Such agricultural bulk water sales are to be made at the time of minimum system demand under the direct control of City personnel and subject to water availability.

The availability of water is to be determined by the system demand, reservoir levels and groundwater drawdown. The determination of availability shall be made by the City Administrator and the decision of the City Administrator shall be final.

ADOPTED by the City Council at the City of Wilsonville at a regular meeting thereof this 7th day of September, 1982, and filed with the Wilsonville City Recorder this same day.
