

RESOLUTION NO. 277

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 204 ARTICLE III SECTION 5.

WHEREAS, upon determining that some businesses in Wilsonville were connected to the sanitary sewer system, but utilized their own water source, it was necessary to modify the billing procedure for those businesses since the City's billing process is established to bill sanitary sewer service from total water consumption minus irrigation water utilized, and,

WHEREAS, some businesses in the City utilize water for purposes other than for water closets or discharge to the sanitary sewer system, in these instances the sewer billing should not reflect the total water consumption, but should be based on the amount of water discharged to the sanitary sewer.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City of Wilsonville that:

Discharge into the sanitary sewer of greater than 220,000 cu. ft. per month as measured from the building sewer.</li><li>2. B.O.D. loading of greater than 750 lbs month as measured from the building sewer.</li><li>3. S.S. of more than 250 lbs/mo. as measured from the building sewer.</li></ol>

\*\* Cubic feet of discharge shall be measured from the discharge point of the building sewer into the public sanitary sewer, and shall be based on the average daily discharge as measured.



Domestic water consumption - less irrigation water used is proportionately a minimum of three (3) times greater than measured sanitary sewer discharged	\$13.75/mo/unit connected	** .007/ cuft/mo.	** .005/ cuft/month where 1 or more of the following conditions prevail: 1. Discharge into the sanitary sewer of greater than 220,000 cu.ft. per month as measured from the building sewer. 2. B.O.D. loading of greater than 750 lbs month as measured from the building sewer. 3. S.S. of more than 250 lbs./mo. as measured from the building sewer.

\*\* Cubic feet of discharge shall be measured from the discharge point of the building sewer into the public sanitary sewer, and shall be based on the average daily discharge as measured.
