

RESOLUTION NO. 350

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE BID FOR THE TRACTOR & MOWER; AND TILT BED TRAILER; ACCEPTING THE QUALIFIED LOW BIDDER; AND APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF THE TRACTOR AND MOWER AND TILT BED TRAILER.

WHEREAS, the City Council at their regularly scheduled City Council meeting held on August 1, 1983, at 7:30 P.M. at the Willamette Valley Wesleyan Church, 29775 Town Center Loop East, did adopt Resolution #344, "A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING STAFF TO ADVERTISE TO RECEIVE SEALED BIDS FOR A LAWN TRACTOR MOWER, TILT BED UTILITY TRAILER AND STORAGE BUILDING AT ELLIGSEN RESERVOIR"; and

WHEREAS, staff did authorize advertisements to receive sealed bids for the above mentioned equipment in the Daily Journal of Commerce and the Wilsonville-Tigard Times, pursuant to the requirements as set forth in ORS 279.025 "REQUIREMENT FOR ADVERTISEMENT"; and

WHEREAS, six (6) sealed bids were received for the tractor and mower; four (4) sealed bids were received for the tilt bed trailer; and no sealed bids were received for the storage building. These bids were received before 2:00 o'clock P.M. on Monday, August 29, 1983, at Wilsonville City Hall, 30470 S.W.


Parkway Avenue, Suite A & B, Wilsonville, Oregon. Bids were then publicly opened and read aloud after 2:00 o'clock P.M. and are listed in the attached Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City of Wilsonville that:


1. The City Council approve the award of the lowest qualified bid for the tractor and mower to The Power Shop in the amount of five thousand, nine hundred dollars (\$5,900), with the City to take delivery within thirty (30) days of the bid award.
2. The City Council approve the award of the lowest qualified bid for the tilt bed trailer to B. J. Ford Tractor Company, in the amount of one thousand, five hundred, ninety-two dollars and forty-seven cents (\$1,592.47), with the City to take delivery within twenty-one (21) days of the bid award.
3. Direct staff to research specifications, etc., on the storage building and determine why no bids were received. Staff will return to Council at a later date with an updated request on acquisition of the storage building.
4. Approve the allocation of funds from the following accounts for the items listed above:
