

RESOLUTION NO. 584

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF CONDUIT SLEEVES FOR FORCE MAIN CROSSINGS IN THE DAY DREAM RANCH PHASE II SUBDIVISION

WHEREAS, the Boeckman Creek Pump Station Phase II Project was bid, and upon reviewing funding availability it was determined that total funds were not available to construct the project; and

WHEREAS, all bids were rejected according to Oregon Revised Statutes and will not be re-bid until funds are available; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the Boeckman Creek Pump Station - Phase II included a force main to be constructed through the Day Dream Ranch Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, Day Dream - Phase II is presently under construction and the force main crossing should be placed in order to avoid cutting and patching a new street in the near future; and


WHEREAS, the cost for installation of the conduit crossings are estimated at a cost not to exceed \$4,200.00 ; and

WHEREAS, funds for placement of such installation shall be appropriated from account number 02-50 7221000; and


WHEREAS, the Finance Director has verified that funds are available to pay for said installation.

1. Authorization is hereby approved for the installation of conduit crossings for the force main of the Boeckman Creek Pump Station - Phase II by Northwest Earthmovers, Inc.
2. Funds for said installation shall be allocated from account number 02-50 7221000.
3. The Finance Director by the Signature below verifies that funds are available for this project.
