

RESOLUTION NO. 661

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CANVASS OF VOTES AT THE SPECIAL ELECTION ON MARCH 22, 1988.

WHEREAS, under Resolution 648, the Wilsonville City Council placed a ballot measure before the legal voters of the City of Wilsonville with the question of contracting a water system revenue bond indebtedness in an amount not to exceed \$2,320,000 to finance water system improvements including a new water storage reservoir, additional wells and water mainlines; and

WHEREAS, the election of the registered voters of Clackamas County was conducted by mail and at the polling booths in Washington County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wilsonville has received the canvass of votes cast at the March 22, 1988 special election.
