LOAN OF FUNDS TO LID #5

As you are aware, the settlement on LID #5 regarding how and where the final cost overruns will be distributed has not been determined.

Resolution #620 (approved June 15, 1987) and Resolution #630 (approved August 3, 1987) authorized the loan of funds to be repaid by the end of FY 1987-88.

Since the matter has not yet be resolved, it will be necessary to continue this loan for another term and ask Council to approve a new loan of these funds.

RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize a loan in the amount of \$320,000.00 to the LID #5 fund. with \$200,000.00 coming from the Sewer Operating fund and 120,000.00 from the System Development fund. Interest accrued in FY 1987-88 and interest accrued in FY 1988-89 will be paid at the rate earned by the Local Government Pool during the corresponding time period.
