

RESOLUTION NO. 810

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING PASSAGE OF THE 1991
CLACKAMAS LIBRARY NETWORK OPERATIONS SERIAL LEVY

WHEREAS, Clackamas County has, since 1987, had a countywide serial levy supporting library services for all its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the library serial levy has provided a significant level of funding to the City of Wilsonville for the operation of the public library; and


WHEREAS, the library serial levy funds a coordinated countywide library computer system providing enhanced citizen access to library resources and improving operations for each participating library; and

WHEREAS, the Wilsonville City Council considers the continuation of this countywide serial levy to be of great benefit to the citizens of this City and Clackamas County.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE OF CITY WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Wilsonville City Council supports the passage of the 1991 library operations serial levy and urges all citizens to vote 'YES' for the measure on the mail ballot due March 26, 1991.
