

RESOLUTION NO. 981

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF BALLOT MEASURE 3-12, THE CLACKAMAS COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT SERIAL LEVY.

WHEREAS, the need for effective, efficient and coordinated law enforcement is crucial to the people of the City of Wilsonville and Clackamas County; and

WHEREAS, officers in the Wilsonville Police Department are deputies of the Clackamas County Sheriff who are assigned to work for the City of Wilsonville; and

WHEREAS, said deputies have consistently provided the City of Wilsonville with an outstanding level of service and support; and

WHEREAS, the Clackamas County Sheriff's Office relies on property taxes derived from a serial levy for its operating budget; and

WHEREAS, without the funding provided by this serial levy, Clackamas County would be forced to reduce or eliminate its Sheriff's Office and the City of Wilsonville Police Department would be placed into a state of upheaval and uncertainty; and

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure 3-12, appearing on the March 23, 1993 mail-in ballot, would, if approved, provide Clackamas County with the funding necessary to continue its law enforcement efforts; and

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure 3-12 would, if approved, lower the tax levy in incorporated areas such as Wilsonville from \$1.55 per \$1,000 of assessed value to \$1.35 per \$1,000 of assessed value; and

WHEREAS, the "Fair and Efficient Law Enforcement Committee", established and recognized by the cities of Clackamas County and the Clackamas County Board of Commissioners, has determined that the proposed levy is a fair and equitable approach to paying for crucial law enforcement services in both incorporated and unincorporated areas of Clackamas County.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City Council of the City of Wilsonville, Oregon, recommends approval of Ballot Measure 3-12 at the March 23, 1993 Special Election.

ADOPTED by the Wilsonville City Council at a regular meeting thereof the 1st day of March, 1993, and filed with the Wilsonville City Recorder this date.
