RESOLUTION NO. 1250

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF MEASURE 3-57, THE CLACKAMAS COUNTY THREE-YEAR LAW ENFORCEMENT LEVY.

WHEREAS, the need for effective, efficient and coordinated law enforcement is crucial to the people of the City of Wilsonville and Clackamas County; and

WHEREAS, officers in the Wilsonville Police Department are deputies of the Clackamas County Sheriff who are assigned to work for the City of Wilsonville; and

WHEREAS, said deputies have consistently provided the City of Wilsonville with an outstanding level of service and support; and

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure 3-57, the Clackamas County Law Enforcement Levy, and Ballot Measure 3-60, the City of Wilsonville Law Enforcement Levy, both appearing on the March 12, 1996, mail-in ballot, re-emphasize the need for efficient and effective service delivery; and

WHEREAS, the county sheriff and the cities of Clackamas County are continuing to work toward coordinated operational efficiencies and effectiveness in law enforcement in the county; and

WHEREAS, the Clackamas County Law Enforcement Levy will provide continued operation of and improvement in the county's system of public safety and criminal justice and will, if approved in conjunction with the City of Wilsonville Law Enforcement Levy, allow the city and county to continue their long-standing contractual arrangement for police services; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the Sheriff's Department patrol services, the Clackamas County Law Enforcement Levy funds public safety and criminal justice functions critical to the goals of the City of Wilsonville;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City Council of the City of Wilsonville, Oregon, recommends to the citizens of Wilsonville and Clackamas County a "yes" vote on Ballot Measure 3-57 in the March 12, 1996, special election.
