A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE'S APPLICATION FOR A CLACKAMAS COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FOR COMMUNITY CENTER EXPANSION

WHEREAS, the Wilsonville Community Center houses a variety of programs that benefit low and moderate income senior citizens including a hot lunch program, legal and health clinics, classes, and other activities; and

WHEREAS, participation in the activities, the hot lunch program and other services, has grown to over 300 seniors per year; and

WHEREAS, the current space available at the center is limited and additional room is needed to fulfill all of the activity and service requests; and

WHEREAS, the building requires retrofitting for earthquake safety; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes this project meets the requirements for a Clackamas County Community Development Block Grant; and

WHEREAS, city staff has completed and submitted an application for a block grant for this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES that the City Council of the City of Wilsonville endorses the application for a Clackamas County Community Development Block Grant to be funded in 1999 for expansion of the Wilsonville Community Center.
