

RESOLUTION NO. 1386

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE REQUESTING THAT THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) LIMIT VEHICULAR PARKING AT THE CHARBONNEAU/I-5 INTERCHANGE

WHEREAS, ODOT has jurisdiction and control of certain roadways within the State of Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the Charbonneau / I-5 Interchange Overcrossing is located along a section of roadway commonly referred to as Interstate 5 and this section of roadway is under the jurisdiction and control of ODOT; and

WHEREAS, the City and ODOT in a cooperative effort have determined that certain limitations on the parking of vehicles in and around the Charbonneau Interchange would be in the best interests of the traveling public in providing safe and congestion movement of vehicles in the area; and

WHEREAS, ODOT has agreed to place limitations on the parking of vehicles in and around the Charbonneau Interchange upon a formal request of the City in the form of a resolution passed by the City Council of the City of Wilsonville; and


WHEREAS, Staff has contacted the affected property owners and the placement limitations on the parking of vehicles in and around the Charbonneau Interchange would not be detrimental to the properties involved; and

WHEREAS, the exact location of the parking limitations will be mutually developed by representatives of ODOT and the City based on appropriate design and sight distance standards.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS
FOLLOWS:


1. The City Council of the City of Wilsonville hereby requests that ODOT limit the parking of vehicles in and around the Charbonneau Interchange in an area to be mutually developed by ODOT and the City based on appropriate design and sight distance standards.
